# Status of Pending Items Involving Waste Disposal

## Austin Resource Recovery Contracts

- Citywide Refuse, Recycling, Organics, and Special Waste Collections
  - Previous contract has been held over, expiring on 12/31/2017
  - Solicitation for a new contract was issued on 6/6/2016 and closed on 7/28/2016
  - New contract request went to council on 12/15/2016, 2/2/2017, and 2/16/2017, and was denied
  - Responses received for that solicitation are no longer valid, so will require a new solicitation
- Expansion of Residential Organics Collection Program
  - Expansion of program has been delayed
  - Previous contract for pilot program has been held over, expiring 10/20/2017
  - Solicitation for a new contract was issued on 5/30/2016, and closed on 6/28/2016
  - New contract request went to council on 3/2/2017, and was postponed indefinitely
  - Offers from solicitation still valid, so could be awarded without resoliciting if it is determined the current scope addresses the policy areas

### Austin Resource Recovery Contracts Cont'd

- Residential Dumpster Collection for Duplex and Four-Plex Customers
  - Issuance of new Solicitation is on hold pending decisions from the Working Group
  - Current contract will be held over until 11/2/2017

# Austin Water Contracts

#### Management of Biosolids Reuse

- Previous contract has been held over, expiring on 3/31/2018
- Solicitation for a new contract was issued on 4/4/2016, and closed on 5/19/2016
- New contract request went to council on 8/11/2016, 10/6/2016, 10/20/2016 and 12/15/2016, and was withdrawn by staff at the direction of Council
- Responses received for that solicitation are no longer valid, so will require a new solicitation

### Sale and Removal of Compost Material

- No existing contract to hold over
- Solicitation for a new contract was issued on 3/28/2016, and closed on 5/3/2016
- New contract request went to council on 8/11/2016, 10/6/2016, and 10/20/2016, after which time the proposal responses expired
- Responses received for that solicitation are no longer valid, so will require a new solicitation
- Currently there are 14 compost piles needing to be removed. After a fire occurred on 5/19/2017 causing an emergency situation, the 2 oldest piles will be sold this week, and 2 additional will be sold through an IFB issued on 5/22/2017, and scheduled to close on 6/13/2017.
