## Summary Description of Photographs

- The following photographs are of the exterior of the Balcones Resources operated and Central Texas Refuse (CTR) owned Wilco Material Recovery Facility (MRF) located at 9801 Chandler Rd., Taylor, TX 76574 and of landfill disposal of what reasonably appears to be baled single stream recyclables from this MRF facility at the Williamson County Landfill located at 600 Landfill Rd. Hutto, TX 78634. This MRF was operated by CTR until earlier this year when CTR reportedly entered into a contract with Balcones. See attached press release.
- Photographs were taken during the period between 9/4/2021 and 10/30/2021, both from a helicopter and from ground level.
- The photographs at the Balcones Resources operated and CTR owned Wilco MRF appear to show large quantities of unsorted single stream recyclables stored in both loose and baled form.
- What appears to be baled unsorted single stream recyclables is stored in large stacks and rows, and numerous similar bales appear to have been placed in CTR roll-off dumpsters on an ongoing basis.
- CTR trucks carrying these roll-off dumpsters were observed traveling from the Balcones/CTR Wilco MRF to the Williamson County Landfill operated by Waste Management, Inc.
- Photographs show these CTR trucks dumping and disposing the baled material at the working face of the Williamson County Landfill.
- Detailed photographs of the landfilled baled material indicate that the material is valuable unsorted single stream recyclables.
- Single stream recyclables from Cedar Park, Hutto, Leander, Round Rock, Pflugerville and Taylor, among other communities, municipal utility districts and homeowners associations, are believed to be received at the Balcones/CTR Wilco MRF.

## Balcones, Central Texas Refuse strike deal on Wilco Recycling

Central Texas Refuse (CTR), a waste hauler based in Austin, Texas, has announced a long-term operating agreement with Balcones Resources Inc., an Austin-based environmental services company. Under the agreement, Balcones will operate CTR's Wilco Recycling facility, located in Taylor, Texas.
